The Best Views and Vistas Collected Together



Orangeville Begins Construction of New Trail

Orangeville has begun work on a new cycling and walking trail to reach from Veteran's Way in the west of Orangeville to Town Line in the south. The first phase, the Veteran's Way Trail connection, is hoped to be complete by September. The second phase will include a boardwalk joining this section once there is approval by

Credit Valley Conservation and the railway tracks have been decommissioned. This is expected to happen in late December.

The trail network will connect to trails running north and south, and east and west of Orangeville. The goal of the trail is to connect Orangeville by alternative ways of active transportation.

New Niagara Falls Attraction: Niagara Parks Power Station

Niagara Parks Power Station, the restored former hydroelectric plant at the brink of Niagara Falls, was opened with a ribbon-cutting ceremony on July 28. Built in 1905, it is the only fully intact

decommissioned hydroelectric plant of its period, left in the world. This plant used the water of Niagara Falls to generate electricity. As of Sept. 3, this attraction will be open daily. For tickets see niagaraparks.com/power.
